Class 1 PAIRS HUNTER TRIAL

Riders: Any age

Fences will not generally exceed 100cm. Timed – Speed, (Fastest pair wins)

Entry Fee: £40/ pair Prizes: 1st £60, 2nd £50, 3rd £40

Rosettes to 6th place

Class 2 NOVICE TEAM CHASE

Teams – Riders over 16yrs*

Fences will not generally exceed 100cm. Time – Optimum

Entry fee: £95 Prizes: 1st £105, 2nd £100, 3rd £95

Rosettes to 6th place

Class 3 INTERMEDIATE TEAM CHASE – (SPEED)

Teams – Riders over 16yrs

Fences will not generally exceed 115cm. Time – speed. (Fastest team wins)

PLEASE NOTE NEW SAFETY REGULATIONS WITH HATS AND BODY PROTECTORS

Hats will be identified by a BTC, BE, BRC, or Pony Club approved Hat Tag. I.e. Hats must meet one of the following standards: British All PAS015 1998/2011 with kitemark; VG1 with kitemark; All ASTM F1163: 2004 onwards with SEI mark; SNELL E2001 or E2016 with Snell label and number, or Australian and New Zealand All AS/NZS 3838 2006-onwards hats.

All competitors must also wear a British Equestrian Trade Association (BETA 2009) approved and appropriately labelled Level 3 (purple label) body protector, manufactured in the year 2009 or after. A body protector of this nature is also required when competitors are wearing air jackets of any make.
